## ***Environment: Conservation and Regeneration***

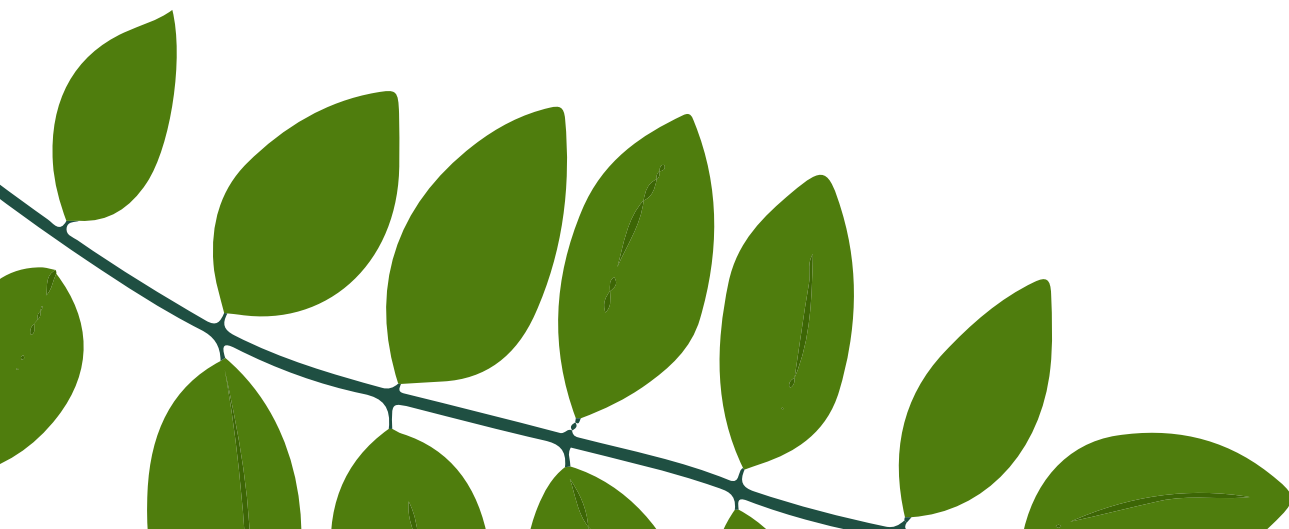
